

## Irregular Verbs in the “yo” form

Infinitive	“yo” form
Hacer = to do, make	hago
Poner = to put	pongo
Salir = to leave, go out	salgo
Traer = to bring	traigo
Traducir = to translate	traduzco
Ver = to see	veo
Tener = to have	tengo

These verbs are irregular in the “yo” form and then they are regular in the rest of the conjugation.

Example:

Hacer is an –ER verb

Yo hago	Nosotros hacemos
Tú haces	Vosotros hacéis
E.l/Ella/Ud. hace	Ellos/ellas/Uds. hacen

Tener is an –ER verb, irregular in the “yo” form that you know already. (It is also a “stem-changing verb e→ie” a category we will see later in the semester.)

Tener = to have

Yo tengo	Nosotros tenemos
Tú tienes	Vosotros tenéis
E.l/Ella/Ud. tiene	Ellos/ellas/Uds. tienen
